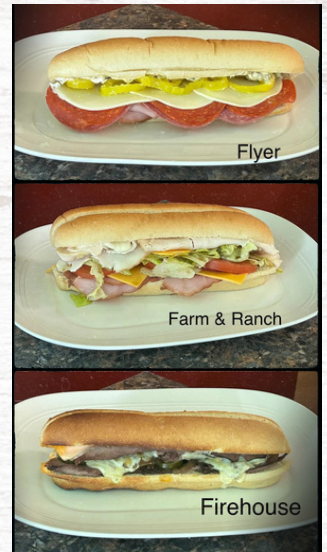


Tim and Melissa Howard started a new café/sandwich shop called Howard's Holy Hoagies located at 106 S. 3rd Street in downtown Humphrey. Howard's Holy Hoagies is a full-service restaurant offering a variety of high-quality sandwiches and soups at a reasonable cost with availability to dine in, carry out or grab and go through their online app. Howard's Holy Hoagies brings additional variety to the Humphrey area, while also providing a "family atmosphere."



They have basic sandwiches as well as special recipe sandwiches that are named after local area teams such as a Flyer (Humphrey St. Francis High School mascot), Bulldog (Humphrey Public High School mascot), EMT and the Firehouse. Most recently, they added a food trailer promoted as Hoagies "On-The-Go" which allows them to participate in neighborhood parties, employer events, county fairs, wedding rehearsal dinners and other on-site daily events in surrounding towns advertised in advance.
