

Michael Tabbert and Brian Ferris have opened Two Bills Steakhouse located at 211 Iowa Street in Clearwater, formerly operated as the L Bar B Steakhouse. Michael and Brian have had a long-time dream and desire to honor their families, serve their community and fill the

need for an upscale yet casual restaurant. The name, Two Bills, pays homage to the owners' fathers, Bill Ferris, a twenty-year Air Force veteran and Bill Tabbert, a lifetime educator and coach in Nebraska.

Two Bills is moderately priced and the menu will be filled with traditional steakhouse items coupled with comfort food. Two Bills will offer hamburgers, broasted chicken, shrimp, fish, steak, pasta, soup, appetizers, fresh bread and more. Specialty selections will include homemade appetizers, a soup and salad bar, smaller portions for children and vegetarian and gluten-free options. They plan to be open seven days a week, mainly in the evenings. "I want people to walk away thinking it was a really good experience. The service, the food, the whole nine yards. To me that's the most important thing. That everyone who comes in walks away happy," Brian Ferris said.

Northeast Nebraska Economic Development District (NENEDD) provided funding and partnered with Cornerstone Bank in Clearwater and the Village of Clearwater's LB840 funds for the business purchase. Everyone also partnered with Loren Kucera, Director of the Nebraska Business Development Center, for business plan and loan packaging assistance.
